

Scholarship Rules for the Applying Applicants

The applicant must submit the application, Sponsor letter, unofficial transcript and essay to the central office at Webster's United Food Service by Monday, April 1, 2019. No late or partial applications will be accepted.

There are two applications to choose from: High School Senior and High School Graduate Continuing Education. Please make sure you fill out the correct application. All scholarship winners will be announced following the meeting in April.

Scholarship Rules for the Winning Applicants

The winners of our scholarships must be enrolled in college within one year after receiving the award. The winner has 3 years to use scholarship total. After three years the amount will be forfeited. Scholarships can be used to pay for tuition and books only. In order to receive the scholarship money, the student must bring in the following to the central office at Webster's United Food Service:

1. Grades from his/her first semester of college; and
2. Copy of Tuition Bill must be submitted to the Webster Foundation 15 days prior to due date. Webster Foundation will issue payment within 5 days of receipt directly to Institution.
3. Should you win this scholarship no further services are required or implied.
